Compared to the previous S-Series appliances, the new hardware platform offers significant performance improvements, deployment flexibility, greater scalability and cost savings. In conjunction with the new offerings, an End of Life (EOL) **notification** was issued for the current S200/S400/S500 Proxy, MACH5, Standard Reverse Proxy, and Advanced Reverse Proxy hardware appliances. The EOL policy ensures you will continue to receive support as outlined in your specific agreement to enable you to easily migrate to the new platform. Making it simpler to buy Email Security

One of the operational improvements the Email team has made is to dramatically reduce the number of Email Security license types we offer. Across the Email Security.cloud and Symantec Messaging Gateway (SMG) products, the number of SKUs on offer has reduced by 99%, moving from around 3,200 license options, to now just under 30. We have consolidated a large number of license options to make it simpler to bundle important add-ons to our core email security licenses. This change makes it easier for customers (or their technology partners) to select and purchase the most appropriate license. For example, we offer a license that includes both our cloud service and on-premises SMG appliance in a single bundle.

Symantec WebFilter EOL announcement

Broadcom is announcing that Symantec WebFilter (formerly known as Blue Coat WebFilter or BCWF) will reach end of life August 31, 2023. Customers using WebFilter today will be able to continue to renew and add capacity to their service until August 31, 2022. This lifecycle adjustment will help customers take advantage of Symantec's next-generation web intelligence technology: Symantec Intelligence Services. Symantec Intelligence Services contains all of the functionality of WebFilter plus new features such as: Risk Levels, GeoIP Location, CASB Applications. What's more, Symantec Intelligence Services Standard maintains the same cost as WebFilter.
